If you are applying for a place at a Catholic School for September 2021 please read this information very carefully as some forms can be sent and completed digitally via email and can avoid the need to print out paper copies. Either digital or paper copies can be can completed, but ALL FAMILIES requesting a reference are asked to email Fr Adrian to obtain a form called the "Parish Reference Request". Whenever possible, Fr Adrian prefers to receive a digital version of the form, photo and baptism certificate sent by email to the Parish Office (details below). If following the paper option, Fr Adrian needs to have the "Parish Reference Request" form printed out and completed by a parent, together with a family photo/print and a copy of the child's baptism certificate in an A4+ size envelope clearly marked School Reference Application with the Name of the Child and Date of handing in to the Parish Office. This form, together with any school forms for Fr Adrian to complete must be posted through the door of the Parish Office on either a Saturday or, at the latest, Sunday. Please do not delay returning the Parish form, as Fr Adrian needs time to collate the family information and when receiving a school reference, he refers back to the Catholic baptism certificate of the child as well as the biographical data. Please note:

The Parish form is NOT the school reference or the school Supplementary Information form, but the data Fr Adrian requires in order to provide them. Please do not confuse this form with the forms required by schools.

Fr Adrian celebrates Mass each day for the needs of the Parish Family: see overleaf for details It is important to note that the obligation to attend Sunday Mass continues to remains suspended.

Our church is only able to open at set times when there are enough volunteers to clean the church before and after.

The church remains closed for repairs Monday to Friday but is open by appointment only on a Saturday for baptisms or the Sacrament of Reconciliation. The church is open from 10.30am to 12pm on Sundays, with an 11am Mass although seats must be pre-booked.

If following the DIGITAL paperless option: please complete the Parish form (this can be easily done using Adobe 'Fill & Sign') and scan a family photo/print (this can be more than one to show the context of the whole family), together with a scanned copy of the child's baptism certificate. Please email these documents and any school forms that can be sent in a digital form to Mortlake@RCAOS.org.uk. Please note: you will still have to collect any digital versions of references that Fr Adrian has printed out for you as below (at noon on Sundays). Once completed, PAPER COPIES of school references handed in the weekend before are to be collected at 12pm (Noon) the following Sunday. This process allows for papers to be decontaminated after 72 hours, completed and left for a further 72 hours to be collected. Please note: Papers cannot be dropped off or collected outside these times. Not everyone will have been able to obtain a place at Mass so the collection of any paper copies of school references at 12pm (Noon) on Sundays is deliberately outside of Mass. as our Sunday Obligation continues to be suspended: no one is penalised for not being able to be at Mass on a Sunday. Please check carefully, as each school differs: if the school has requested that Fr Adrian has to return a paper copy of the reference to the school then the form must be accompanied by an envelope addressed to the school with a stamp attached sufficient for the postage required. A separate envelope is required for each school but, if the reference form is to be returned by the parents, these must be collected at 12pm on Sundays. Forms cannot be returned on other days to allow for the safe quarantine of paper. Please ensure you have provided a plastic cover or envelope to contain all the reference papers you would like back to return to the school yourself. Fr Adrian will be available by the Parish Office to return forms but parents must arrive at the latest by 12pm Noon to ensure they can receive forms emailed or handed in at least the week before. Fr Adrian may contact you if he has any queries but, as it can take 7-10 days to complete the reference and quarantine process, please return your forms promptly. Any reference request that is received less than two weekends before the school's final date of receipt cannot be processed as there will not be enough time for the completion and guarantine process. For example, if the Primary School Reference has to be back by Friday 15 January, the last date to drop the form into the Parish Office is Saturday 2 January to allow for a quarantine of 72 hours before and after completion, so that the reference(s) can be collected from Fr Adrian at Noon on Sunday 10 January. Please note: we cannot accept late applications for seats at Mass. Although we ask for requests within 7 to 10 days, most places are taken with 7 days. We try to ensure that if a person cannot attend one week, that they may be able to attend the week following, but that cannot be guaranteed. We are in great need of Cleaners and Stewards to ensure that we can open.
